

PHD NURSING STUDENT DEAN'S SCHOLAR AWARDS

Announcement and Application

Purpose of the Award

Dean Sally Brosz Hardin has established the PhD Nursing Student Dean's Scholar Awards to recognize academic excellence in PhD students and their potential for development as nurse scientists. Students who receive this award will be active participants in research projects with faculty mentors and participate in all phases of project development and implementation. Students will receive a \$5,000 honorarium, and may be at any point in their enrollment in the PhD program. (Students are eligible to receive this award only once).

Criteria for the Award are that the student:

1. is enrolled in USD's PhD in Nursing program;
2. has a record of academic excellence;
3. has identified a faculty member with an active program of research who has agreed to be a research mentor; and
4. agrees to conduct a dissertation that is closely related to the research mentor's research.
