CERTIFICATION OF FINANCES

The University of San Diego offers merit scholarships to our international students however; you cannot rely solely on financial assistance or awards from the university to support you during your studies. All international students who need to obtain an F-1 or J-1 visa must provide proof of the ability to pay for all of your educational and living expenses. Please complete the Certification of Finances form and in addition, you must submit an official bank document verifying the availability of funds. If your funds are coming from several resources you must indicate each source and provide proper documentation for the entire amount of academic expenses.

Please note that tuition does vary among the doctoral programs as well as the expected units per semester. The tuition listed below is only for fall and spring semesters with 12 units per term. Should the doctoral program require summer and/or winter enrollment, the tuition cost will be different. Please contact the graduate program director for more information.

Married students accompanied by their families will need an additional \$800.00 per month for their spouse, \$300.00 per month for one child, and \$200.00 per month for each additional dependent.
