Furthermore, beginning Fall 2006, freshmen and transfer students are required to meet the Diversity requirement by taking one course. Courses that fulfill the Diversity and the Core Curriculum requirement are identified on the articulation agreement. In some cases, both requirements can be fulfilled by the same course.

**Third semester competency in a second language is required for students seeking the bachelor's degree. Students may demonstrate competency either by successfully completing a third semester course in a second language or by passing the USD competency examination at that level.
