Courses that fulfill the Diversity and the Core Curriculum requirement are identified on the articulation agreement. In some cases, both requirements can be fulfilled by the same course.

**Third semester competency in a second language is required for students seeking the bachelor's degree. Students may demonstrate competency either by successfully completing a third semester course in a second language or by passing the USD competency examination at that level.
