## Alumni Association Scholarship Program Senior Class Legacy Fall 2009

### Introduction

The University of San Diego Alumni Association scholarships for students are made possible by the generous support of alumni donors. Alumni gifts, no matter the amount, enrich the student experience by providing much-needed financial assistance. These scholarships were created by alumni and students who had the vision to support the University's future growth and success. In an effort to connect current students with alumni supporters, opportunities to attend various alumni events are available to scholarship recipients throughout the year.

### Senior Class Legacy Scholarship Overview and Requirements

The Senior Class Legacy scholarship program began in 1989 with three seniors who had the vision to leave a legacy. Sam Attisha '89, David Reiling '89 and Kerry O'Heany Reiling '89 created this scholarship program, by students for students, to ensure that the USD experience would be available for future students. Every year, the senior class raises funds for this scholarship that recognizes freshman, sophomore, junior and senior students who are impacting future USD students through campus involvement. As part of the original vision of the scholarship, additional consideration is given to students who have financial need and are making a lasting impact on the University.

### Senior Class Legacy Scholarship Criteria and Essay:

- Applicant demonstrates that he/she is leaving a legacy through campus involvement that will impact future students at USD.
- Must be a current freshman, sophomore, junior or senior in good standing for the 2009-2010 academic year
- Cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or above
- Consideration will be given to students with financial need
- Required Essay: Please attach an essay, containing 400-500 words, describing how you are leaving a legacy through your campus involvement that will impact future students at USD.

### Application Procedure – Applicants must complete the following application procedures:

- Carefully review the scholarship criteria and essay requirements outlined in this document.
- Complete application in full, sign and date, and submit with required essay.
- Submit application by **Friday, December 4, 2009 at 4 p.m.**

- Notification: Senior Class Legacy Scholarship applicants will be notified by February 1, 2010. Approximately eight scholarships are distributed and awards range from \$1,000 to \$2,000.
