## UNIVERSITY OF SAN DIEGO RECRUITING FOR FALL 2010 MASTER OF SCIENCE IN REAL ESTATE CLASS

**SAN DIEGO, Dec. 10, 2009** — The University of San Diego's Burnham-Moores Center for Real Estate is currently recruiting for the fall 2010 class of its Master of Science in Real Estate (MSRE) program. The program provides students with the leadership, communication and interpersonal skills necessary to compete for real estate careers at the middle- to upper-management levels or to become real estate entrepreneurs.

The cohort-based program will begin in late August 2010 and can be completed in just 10 months as a full-time student, or two years as a part-time student. A joint MBA/MSRE degree can be completed in 2½ years. Students have an average of three years of real estate experience when they enter the program.

“Many real estate professionals are finding this to be a perfect time to pursue graduate school since there is not as much happening on the business front, which affords them more time for graduate studies,” says Ines Kraft, Ph.D., the program's administrative director.

Students in the MSRE program receive a high-caliber education and gain a full comprehension of the many different facets of real estate, including financial analysis, sustainability, asset management and development. Students also pursue Argus and LEED accreditations as part of the curriculum.
