



RICHARD A. COLLATO

Richard Collato has been the President and Chief Executive Officer of the YMCA of San Diego County since January, 1981 and is a member of the board of directors. The YMCA of San Diego County is the 2nd largest YMCA in the United States (over \$125 million in annual revenues, more than 4,500 employees and 240,000 members and participants). He formerly served seven years as Vice President Branch Operations of the YMCA of Metropolitan Los Angeles and as Executive Director for the Los Angeles' largest YMCA, the San Pedro Peninsula Branch.

Mr. Collato was a member of the San Diego Downtown Rotary Club from 1981 to August, 2002. He was a continuous member of Rotary since 1970 and President of the San Pedro, California Rotary Club in 1978. He was named "Director of the Year 2002" by the Corporate Directors Forum and was named San Diego Business Journal's "2007 CEO of the Year for Lifetime Achievement." He is an adjunct professor at the University of San Diego where he teaches accounting and governance at the graduate level.

He has served on the Board of Directors of Surge Global Energy (SRGG), Y-Mutual Ltd., a Bermuda based reinsurance company which he helped to start, The Bank of San Diego (Audit Committee chair and served on Loan Committee & President Search Committee), Springfield College, San Diego Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Gas Company, Enova, Microvision Optical and the Jenna Druck Foundation. He is currently a director for three public companies: **Sempra Energy** (SRE) where he served as Audit Committee Chair for 3 years and currently serves on the Governance and Compensation Committees, and **WD-40** (WDFC) currently serving on Audit and as Chairman of the Compensation Committee, and **PepperBall Technologies** (PBALL). He is also director for **Project Design Consultants**, a San Diego based civil engineering company, and chairs its Compensation Committee. Collato is a Trustee, Vice Chairman of the Board and Chair of the

Governance Committee and a member of the compensation, investment and executive committees, of the \$5 billion **YMCA Retirement Fund** headquartered in New York City.

He is a graduate from Pepperdine University School of Business having earned his MBA Degree in Management. His Bachelor's Degree is in Business Administration (BBA) from The College of Insurance (Saint John's University).

He resides in Del Mar, California where he lives with his wife of 35 years, Cathy. Their two children: Brandi (26) who earned her BBA and MA degrees at the University of San Diego, and Christopher (21) is an Accounting major attending Loyola Marymount University Los Angeles in his senior year.
