

MINOR IN ACCOUNTING

The minor in accounting is designed to support and enhance the education provided by other courses and majors in the university.

The minor in accounting requires a minimum of 18 units from the following:

Lower-division required courses (6 units)

- ACCT 201 Principles of Financial Accounting
- ACCT 202 Principles of Managerial Accounting

Upper-division required courses (6 units)

- ACCT 300 Intermediate Accounting I
- ACCT 302 Cost Accounting

Upper-division elective course (6 units)

- Any two pre-approved ACCT electives

Courses taken in the minor may not be counted toward a major but may be used to satisfy preparation for a major and for core curriculum requirements.
