



Business Administration Minor

The Business Administration minor is designed to support and enhance the education provided by other courses and majors in the university.

The business administration minor requires a minimum of 18 units. Courses taken in the minor may not be counted toward a major but may be used to satisfy preparation for a major and for core curriculum requirements.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION MINOR

The minor in business administration requires a minimum of 18 units from the following:

Lower-division required courses (9 units)

- ACCT 201 Principles of Financial Accounting
- ECON 101 Principles of Microeconomics
- ECON 102 Principles of Macroeconomics

Upper-division required course (3 units)

- MGMT 300 Organizational Behavior

Upper-division elective courses (6 units)

- Any pre-approved business elective (not ACCT or ECON)
