



Economics Minor

The Economics minor is designed to support and enhance the education provided by other courses and majors in the university.

The economics minor requires a minimum of 18 units. Courses taken in the minor may not be counted toward a major but may be used to satisfy preparation for a major and for core curriculum requirements.

ECONOMICS MINOR

The minor in economics requires a minimum of 18 units from the following:

Lower-division required courses (12 units)

- ECON 101 Principles of Microeconomics
- ECON 102 Principles of Macroeconomics
- ECON 201 Intermediate Microeconomics
 or upper-division ECON elective
- ECON 202 Intermediate Macroeconomics
 or upper-division ECON elective

Upper-division elective courses (6 units)

- Any pre-approved ECON electives
