The Law and Ethics minor is designed to support and enhance the education provided by other courses and majors in the university.

The law and ethics minor requires a minimum of 18 units. Courses taken in the minor may not be counted toward a major but may be used to satisfy preparation for a major and for core curriculum requirements.

LAW AND ETHICS MINOR

The minor in law and ethics requires a minimum of 18 units from the following:

Lower-division required courses (6 units)
