Undergraduate Program Ranked #40 by Bloomberg Businessweek

The University of San Diego is ranked 40th in the nation in Bloomberg Businessweek's 2012 list of the top 50 undergraduate business programs. USD has made the top-50 list for six consecutive years, and was awarded an A+ grade for teaching quality for the fifth consecutive year. The school also received an A+ grade for facilities and services, and an A grade for job placement.

In academic specialty rankings released by Bloomberg Businessweek in May, 2011, USD was recognized for excellence in several categories, including:

- Business Law #12
- Ethics #6
- Sustainability #5

This is the sixth consecutive year that USD's undergraduate business program has been ranked among the top five on the West Coast.

Princeton Review Ranks University of San Diego #2 Best Campus Environment

The 2012 edition of the Princeton Review Guide to the Best Business Schools lists USD as the second best campus environment among the 294 business schools they rate. The ranking is based on surveys of more than 19,000 students at schools across the country. This marks the third consecutive year that the University of San Diego's campus environment has been ranked among the top five by the Princeton Review.

Bloomberg Businessweek Ranks USD's Evening MBA #14 in the Country

The University of San Diego's Evening Master of Business Administration is ranked among the best in the country, according to Bloomberg Businessweek's latest list of the top part-time MBA programs. The ratings are based on surveys of academic quality and student satisfaction. Bloomberg Businessweek ranked the top 76 schools, among more than 500 eligible AACSB accredited business schools.

In addition, Bloomberg Businessweek graded the San Diego MBA:

- A+ for teaching quality
- A+ for how students rate the caliber of their fellow classmates
- A+ for the MBA curriculum

MBA Program Ranked Among the Best in the World for Social Responsibility by the Aspen Institute.

The University of San Diego's master of business administration program is ranked 39th in the world for integrating social, environmental and ethical issues into its curriculum, according to the Aspen Institute's 2011-2012 edition of "Beyond Grey Pinstripes."

This marks USD the third consecutive Beyond Grey Pinstripes survey in which USD has had the highest ranked MBA program in Southern California. It is also the third straight time that the school has been ranked among the top 50 programs in the world.
