The Supply Chain Management minor is designed to support and enhance the education provided by other courses and majors in the university.

The supply chain management minor requires a minimum of 18 units. Courses taken in the minor may not be counted toward a major but may be used to satisfy preparation for a major and for core curriculum requirements.

SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT MINOR

The minor in supply chain management requires a minimum of 18 units from the following:
