Honors Program
Mid-Year Admit Process

Current USD students interested in entering the Honors Program must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for admission in the spring or fall semester:

1. Students must submit a complete Honors Program application
2. Students must receive *at least* a 3.4 cumulative USD GPA by the end of the semester in which they are currently studying
3. Students must receive a recommendation to enter the program from a faculty member
4. Complete applications are due by the end of the day on the last day of classes

All application materials, including the faculty recommendation, should be sent to Meghan Ayers in the Honors Program Office, Founders 119, or via email to mayers@sandiego.edu.

*Incoming freshman must receive the Trustee Merit Scholarship through the Office of Undergraduate Admissions in order to be considered for admission into the Honors Program. Students not on a Trustee Merit Scholarship may enter in the spring semester provided they meet the above criteria.
