Students will enroll for either the 435-437 classes or the 485-87 classes depending on whether they are Political Science or International Relations majors. Students who are not majors in these disciplines can still participate in the Washington Center program and earn credits from other departments (with department approval).

Political Science and International Relations majors are able to apply 3 units of the internship credit to their major. The other 3 units will count as an elective. In addition, the directed study will count towards

the major. In total, students will earn six units toward the Political Science or International Relations major while participating in the Washington Center Internship Program.

The Washington Center Course will be taken in Washington, D.C. The course meets once a week for three hours. Students will choose this course in consultation with the Washington Center Campus Advisor.

The directed study will be taken with the Washington Center Campus Advisor. The student will complete a research paper for this course.
