- 1.) Your USD Student ID Card will be activated with your meal plan information and will now serve as your meal plan card. **The meal plan is for the exclusive use of the card holder.** It may not be resold, assigned, transferred, or used by anyone else under any condition. Use by anyone else may result in a fine.
- 2.) Meals will be available only when USD is in regular Undergraduate session. **No meals will be offered during Thanksgiving, Christmas, Spring or Easter breaks. The last meal of the semester is on the last weekday of exams.** Meals do not carry over into Intersession, or semester to semester. The first meal of each semester will begin with dinner the night before the first day of classes. For Easter vacation, meals will begin with dinner on the Monday immediately following Easter Sunday.
- 3.) For your protection, if you lose your ID card you must report it within 24 hours to Campus Card Services. Contact their office by phone at (619) 260-5999 or report it in person at their office in the Bookstore, Loma Hall. **If you do not report the loss of your card within 24 hours you will be liable for any meals used, and charges accrued, up until the time the card is reported missing.**

USD DINING SERVICES MEAL PLAN CONTRACT

All students are given the option of the Encore 200, 150, 100, or 75 meal plan. MEAL PLANS CAN NOT BE LOWERED AFTER THE 15TH CLASS DAY OF ANY SEMESTER.

- a.) You must present your ID card every time you use the dining facilities; including entrance into the dining room during regularly scheduled meals. Without your card you must pay cash. If you forget your card, you may purchase a meal with cash at the guest meal rate in the Main Dining Room. (Refunds are only applicable for a meal purchased in the Main Dining Room.) Get a receipt at the time of purchase and then bring the receipt and your ID card to the Main Dining entrance check stand for your refund.
- b.) The Main Dining Room is an all-you-care-to-eat facility. You may enjoy your meals within the dining room. Food is not allowed out of Main Dining.
- c.) If you run out of meals you may purchase campus cash, or a new meal plan, at the Campus Card Services Office in the Bookstore, Loma Hall. anytime through the end of the academic school year in May. Campus Cash may also be added to your ID card online www.sandiego.edu/campuscard.
- d.) At the end of each semester all Meal Plan accounts are closed.
