GENERAL INFORMATION

Students with academic year Federal Work-Study awards may be able to work during summer. To be eligible you will need to

- have been awarded Federal Work-Study for the 2011-2012 or 2012-2013 academic year,
- be enrolled at USD for the 2012 Fall semester,
- be given permission to work by both the hiring department and the Student Employment Center, and
- submit a completed Summer Session Work Referral to the Student Employment Center (SEC) **BEFORE** starting work.

Students who work during summer are not required to be taking classes at USD. Earnings during summer do not count toward the total amount that a student may earn through Federal Work-Study during the academic year.

If you plan to take a class during Summer Session and are interested in receiving financial aid, please also submit the 2012 Summer Supplemental Financial Aid Application.
