STUDENTS WHO STARTED THEIR CURRENT PROGRAM AT USD PRIOR TO FALL 2004

(A) UNDERGRADUATES

1. **Tuition:**
\$14,800 is the cost of tuition for one semester for 12 to 18 units. The cost for each unit below 12 or over 18 is \$1,025.
2. **Fees:**
Fees are \$125 for one semester for 12-18 units (includes a Health Service Fee). For 7 - 11.5 units, fees are \$77 per semester. For 3 - 6.5 units, fees are \$56 per semester;
3. **On-Campus Room and Board:**
\$5138-5978 is the range of on-campus room and board costs for one semester for a student in double occupancy who contracts for the Encore 150 meal plan. Your specific costs may vary depending on your room assignment and meal plan selection.

(A) UNDERGRADUATES

1. **Tuition:**
\$16,150 is the cost of tuition for one semester for 12 to 18 units. The cost for each unit below 12 or over 18 is \$1,115.
2. **Fees:**
Fees are \$132 for one semester for 12-18 units (includes a Health Service Fee). For 7 - 11.5 units, fees are \$77 per semester. For 3 - 6.5 units, fees are \$56 per semester;
3. **On-Campus Room and Board:**
\$5138-5978 is the range of on-campus room and board costs for one semester for a student in double occupancy who contracts for the Encore 150 meal plan. Your specific costs may vary depending on your room assignment and meal plan selection.

Fees are \$77 for one semester for 7 units or more (includes a Health Services fee). For 1 - 6.5 units, fees are \$67 per semester.

Use your electronic *Offer of Financial Assistance* to calculate the amount of financial aid you will receive each semester. Do not include FWS or CWO amounts listed on your *E-Offer*. Subtract this amount from your Tuition, Fees, (and Room and Board) charges. This is the estimated amount you will need to pay to the Student Accounts Office or, if your financial aid exceeds your charges, the amount that will be refunded to you
