

How to Log In to CE6 (WebCT/Blackboard)

1. Go to the web address <http://pop.e.sandiego.edu>

Browser Check (<http://www.webct.com/tuneup/>)


Before logging in, it is highly recommended that you perform a browser check to see if your computer is properly configured to use the Blackboard Learning System. Please pay special attention to disable “pop up” blockers and “download” information.

2. Click on the Check Browser button. Follow the instructions for optimal browser configuration.

3. Type your USD Unet (email) user name and password.

Note: If you need to set up your Unet account, go to <http://mail.sandiego.edu> and click on Open an Account (Students). If you have any problem with this process, you can stop by at Serra 205 lab for assistance.
