

Running the Wimba Setup Wizard

Before you enter a Live Classroom for the first time, you will want to be sure to go through the setup wizard. You need only do this one time unless you change your computer configuration or hardware.

This wizard will test your system for voice and audio capabilities and ensure that you are able to take full advantage of the features in the room.

Be sure you have your microphone and speakers connected prior to beginning this wizard.

Click on the words 'setup wizard' to begin.

When the screen you see here appears, click on 'Start' to begin the system check and simply follow the instructions on each screen.

The wizard will check for pop-up blocking, Java compatibility, and text chat capabilities when you first click on 'start'.

Follow the instructions for allowing the signed applet ...

Next, the audio levels will be detected and you should hear a voice recorded message prompting you to click on 'next'.

Similarly, on the next screen you will hear a series of tones and be asked to speak into the microphone. Hold down the 'talk' button with your mouse, or the control key on your keyboard in order to activate the talk feature.

If at any point along the way you are experiencing difficulty, click on the blue troubleshooting links.

Once you have finished the wizard, you should see check marks in all of the boxes on the left panel indicating that your system has been checked and will operate properly within Wimba.
