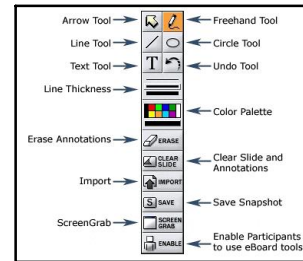


## eBoard Tools in Wimba Live Classroom

In Live Classroom, load a Powerpoint presentation into the eBoard area. \*Note: the presentation must be targeted to the eBoard in the initial upload process. eBoard can only be used with web images, Powerpoint files, and screenshots of desktop applications.

A brief overview of the tools available in the eBoard ... Simply click on any tool to activate.



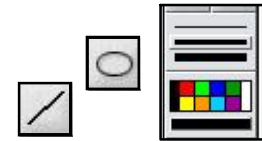
**The Pointer Tool**—by clicking on this you can add arrows to your slides. To change the direction in which the arrow is pointing simply click on the arrow in the console to rotate it.



**The Freehand Draw Tool**—this tool allows you to draw on the eBoard with your mouse. You can use the Color Palette and Line Thickness tools to change the appearance of the line.



**The Circle & Line Tools**—Use these tools to draw circles, ovals and lines. Click the mouse and drag to create the shape. Change the appearance using the Color Palette and Line Thickness Tool.



**The Text Tool**—Add notations to your slide. Select the text tool, click on the slide and a grey box will appear indicating you may begin typing. Hit enter on your keyboard when done. Again, the Color Palette can be used to enhance the appearance of the text.



**The Undo Tool**—By clicking on this icon you can remove the last whiteboard marking. Repeated clicking of this will continue to remove markings.



**The Erase Tool**—Clicking on this will erase any markup that you have added to a slide.



**The Clear Tool**—Clicking on this will remove all markup and images from the eBoard, leaving it completely white.



**The Import Tool**—Allows you to import a graphic or image into the eBoard.



**The Save Tool**—With this tool you can capture a screenshot of your slide including any markup you have made with the eBoard tools. Simply click on 'save' and the screenshot will be added to the Snapshots folder in the drop down menu of your presenter's console.



**The Screen Grab Tool**—This tool allows you to post to the eBoard a static screenshot of a computer application or part of your desktop. Before you can use Screen Grab, you must install the Screen Grab Controller (see online help).



**The Enable Tool**—This tool is used to grant limited eBoard access to some or all of the participants in your Live Classroom.
