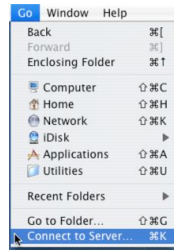


## Macintosh OS X:

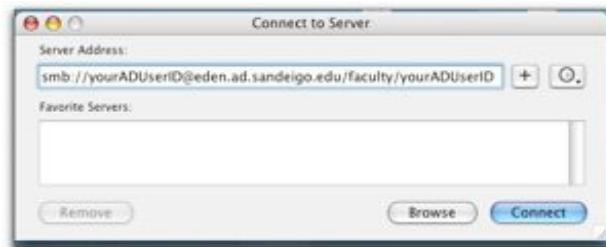
Mac OS X is equipped with built-in Samba technology that allows it to map your personal account on the Central File Server and view it as a folder. This is much like mapping your H: drive on a Windows computer.

### To connect to the Central File Server

1. With the Finder active, select **Connect to Server...** from the **Go** menu, or from the keyboard use # **K**.



2. In the **Connect to Server** window, type the following **Address** field:  
**smb://eden.ad.sandiego.edu/faculty/yourADUserID** and click on the **Connect** button



3. You will be presented with the SMB/CIFS Filesystem Authentication window
4. Enter **AD** for Workgroup/Domain
5. Enter your ADUserID for Username and your University password. Your exact login screen will depend on your Mac OS version.

6. The mapped drive will appear on your desktop where you can begin to drag and drop your important documents onto the Central File Server.



7. If you need to access the drive again, double-click the FACULTY icon on your desktop



8. It will show all users' folder, double-click the folder with yourADUserID.
