Representations in Job Application Materials Policy

Any misrepresentation in your job application materials (including the rounding up of your GPA or class rank) is considered a violation of Section 3.02 of the Honor Code of the University of San Diego School of Law. Such misrepresentation may result in serious sanctions from the School of Law.

Furthermore, the Career Services Office will not submit your application materials to an employer if the Career Services Office is aware of any misrepresentation. It is your responsibility to ensure that your resume and any other application materials accurately state your class rank, GPA, extracurricular activities, awards and all other material information before you submit them to employers.

By participating in recruiting activities through Career Services, you agree that you have read and understand the terms of this Representations in Job Application Materials Policy, and you further agree to comply with the terms and requirements herein. You also release the Career Services Office and all personnel thereof from responsibility for any events or consequences that arise from or that relate to the submission of your application materials if such application materials do not comply with the terms and requirements of the Representations Policy or any Honor Code section that relate thereto.
