The multi-volume DOBBS LAW OF REMEDIES: DAMAGES, EQUITY, RESTITUTION and the hornbook LAW OF REMEDIES: DAMAGES, EQUITY, RESTITUTION, also by Dobbs, were both published in 1993 and have not been updated since then. If they had been supplemented or otherwise updated, we would have automatically received the updates. Furthermore, I was surprised to learn that our vendor and publisher databases do not list any more recent treatises on U.S. remedies law. If or when new versions are published, you can be certain that we will purchase them.
