Sample database – Legislative History (LH) : U.S. Code, 1948 to Present, which includes "...all congressional reports, including reports on bills that did not become law, beginning with 1990. Also sets out the legislative history of public laws as reprinted in U.S. Code Congressional and Administrative News (USCCAN) from 1948 through 1989, as well as legislative history of securities laws beginning in 1933 and presidential signing statements reprinted in USCCAN beginning in 1986."
