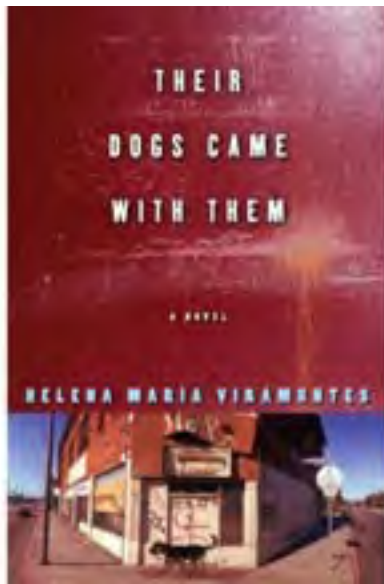


**Acclaimed Chicana author
