Comprehensive Exam Calendar
Fall 2007

The MAIR comprehensive exam is offered twice every semester. In the Fall, the first session begins in mid-September and oral exams end by mid-November. The second session begins in early October and oral exams end by mid-December. Important due dates are listed below. For more information about the requirements of the exam please see the Information and Guidelines for the MAIR Comprehensive Exam.

Important notes: All students who plan to take the comprehensive exam during **Fall 2007** (first or second session) must indicate their intention to take the exam by submitting a tentative question by **12 noon on Wednesday, September 12** to the Political Science office, IPJ 261.

First Session: Students taking the exam in the first session must also submit dossiers (See Information and Guidelines sheet) by **12 noon on Wednesday, September 12**.

Second Session: Students will have an opportunity to revise their proposed question before formally beginning the exam process. On **October 3**, students must submit their completed dossiers, including the final version of their proposed question by **12 noon** to IPJ 261.

Fall Session 1 (**Dates for Fall Session 2 appear in parentheses.**)

Wednesday, September 19 (**October 10**): Questions Available after 12 noon in IPJ 261.

Wednesday, October 3 (**October 24**): Three copies of paper due by 12 noon in IPJ 261.

Wednesday, October 17 (**November 7**): Notification of Results: Pass, Rewrite, or Fail. Please contact dept. office for results.

Wednesday, October 24 (**November 14**): Rewrites due by 12 noon in IPJ 261. Please resubmit the two copies of the original draft along with three copies of the revised essay.

Monday, November 5 (**Monday, November 26**): First day of Oral Exams.
