



USD First-Year Student Move-in and Arrival Instructions OLÉ! Weekend – Friday, Sept. 1

In order to ensure a safe and efficient move-in process, we have designed a move-in schedule and procedure for each residential area. This applies only to first-year students living in these areas. Transfer student move-in will take place on Saturday, Sept. 2. Returning student move-in begins on Monday, Sept. 4. **Move-in times will be enforced** for both safety reasons and so we may adequately assist you. Find your move-in time based on the building to which you are assigned for the year. It is important that you park in the designated areas and follow the directions of all USD staff, volunteers and posted signs. **Welcome Team members will assist you in moving into your rooms.**

Please label your belongings with your last name, building and room number to assist the Welcome Team as they help unload your belongings and get them into your new space.



For all areas, you will need to print out the free Move-In Day parking pass for your assigned move-in time. A parking pass is required for all vehicles unloading during move-in.

Instructions regarding how to obtain your Move-In Day unloading and parking pass will be emailed to all incoming first-year students on Aug. 1. Once your pass is printed, post it in a visible manner in the lower driver-side corner of your windshield prior to arriving on campus.

The move-in permit is valid for move-in weekend, Sept. 1-5. Student wishing to park a vehicle on campus after Sept. 6 must obtain a campus parking permit from Parking Services.

Students who have been invited to and have RSVP'd for either the First-Generation Student and Family Lunch or the Black Student Welcome Reception will be assigned an early move-in time that does not conflict with these events. These students will receive instructions via email to access these passes.



Make Your USD Move-In Green!

- **REUSE/RECYCLE YOUR CARDBOARD:** Store your boxes to use during move-out or recycle them.
- **CONSERVE WATER:** Remember to turn off the water while you brush your teeth, wash your face, shave, etc. Try to reduce your shower time by a few minutes and only do laundry with a full load.
- **REDUCE YOUR ENERGY CONSUMPTION:** Coordinate with your roommate(s) to rent a refrigerator/microwave. Unplug your electronics when they are not in use and always turn off the lights when leaving a room.
- **BRING YOUR BAGS:** Use a reusable bag when you go shopping on and off campus.
- **BUY GREEN:** Stock up your room with green goodies, such as organic cotton sheets, chemical-free or recycled notebooks and environmentally friendly cleaning products.
- **RECYCLE:** Each room comes with a blue recycling bin. USD has single stream recycling so all recyclable items can go in the blue bin.

- **SHARE THE RIDE:** Rent bikes from Outdoor Adventures to get around town. Or sign-up for iCommute or Zipcar for easy carpooling.
- **GO PAPERLESS:** Bring your laptop to class to take notes if your professor allows it. Read e-books and articles on your computer/tablet instead of printing them out. If you need to print, print double-sided.

Early Arrival for Student Athletes, Summer Bridge Participants and Pre-Orientation Participants

For students who have been approved for move-in prior to Sept. 1 due to participation in Athletics, Summer Bridge and Pre-Orientation experiences with Outdoor Adventures or University Ministry, your program will provide specific information about your arrival date and check-in procedure.

On Sept. 1, you MUST report to the check-in area for your residence hall to collect your OLÉ! Weekend welcome materials and meal card. Any early-arrival students must move their vehicle to the Manchester or Alcalá Vista parking lots by 11:59 p.m. on Aug. 31 to clear space for move-in on Sept. 1.

Camino and Founders Residence Halls

- **Camino Hall residents:** Enter campus via the west entrance and follow signs directing you to Camino Hall.
- As you drive up the hill, stay in the right lane. Turn right at the stop sign adjacent to the Joan B. Kroc Institute for Peace and Justice. Proceed to the Olin Hall lot on your left. Welcome Team student leaders will direct you and assist you with your belongings.
- Report to the check-in tables between Camino and Founders to receive your OLÉ! Weekend materials and check in to your room.
- Immediately after your vehicle is unloaded, ***you or someone from your party must move the vehicle to the West Parking Structure (see map)***. From there, a tram will bring you back to Camino Hall.

- **Founders Hall residents:** Enter campus via the west entrance and follow signs directing you to Founders Hall. As you drive up the hill, enter the left lane. Turn left between Mother Rosalie Hill Hall and Copley Library. Follow the signs directing you behind Camino Hall/Founders Hall. Turn right into the Immaculata West lot. Welcome Team student leaders will direct and assist you with your belongings.
- Report to the check-in tables between Camino and Founders to receive your OLÉ! Weekend materials and check in to your room.
- Immediately after your vehicle is unloaded, ***you or someone from your party must move the vehicle to the West Parking Structure (see map)***. From there, a tram will bring you back to Founders Hall.

Maher Hall

- **Maher Hall residents:** Enter campus via the west entrance. Turn left between Mother Rosalie Hill Hall and the Copley Library. Follow the signs directing you behind Camino/Founders Hall, the Immaculata and then around Maher Hall to the unloading area near the front of the building. Unloading will take place in the circle and adjacent Hahn University Center parking lot. Welcome Team student leaders will have carts and will assist with your belongings.
- Report to the station in front of your assigned area to receive your OLÉ! Weekend materials and check in to your room.
- Immediately after your vehicle is unloaded, ***you or someone from your party must move the vehicle to the West Parking Structure (see map)***. From there, a tram will bring you back to Maher Hall.

Mission Housing Complex (The Valley)

- **Missions A/San Antonio De Padua (SAP) residents:** Enter campus via the main entrance. Make a right turn at the intersections circle and follow the signs directing you past the Jenny Craig Pavilion and onto San Buenaventura Way to enter the Mission housing area. **Missions A residents**, turn right at the stop sign into the unloading area. **SAP residents**, turn left at the stop sign, then turn left onto Santa Paula Drive. Follow the signs to Missions A/SAP check-in. Welcome Team student leaders will direct and assist you with your belongings.
- Report to the table outside Mission Crossroads to receive your OLÉ! Weekend materials and your housing information to check in to your room.
- Immediately after your vehicle is unloaded, ***you or someone from your party must move the vehicle to the Mission Parking Structure and park in any available space.*** From there, you will be able to walk back to the Mission Housing Complex.

- **Missions B residents:** Enter campus via the main entrance. Make a right-hand turn at the intersection circle and follow the signs directing you past the Jenny Craig Pavilion and onto San Buenaventura Way to enter the Missions housing area. After you pass San Buenaventura Hall, turn left and follow the signs to enter the Missions B parking lot. Welcome Team student leaders will assist with your belongings.
- Go to the Missions B table located adjacent to your assigned building to receive your OLÉ! Weekend materials and your housing information to check in to your room.
- Immediately after your vehicle is unloaded, ***you or someone from your party must move the vehicle to the Mission Parking Structure and park in any available space.*** From there, you will be able to walk back to the Mission Housing Complex.

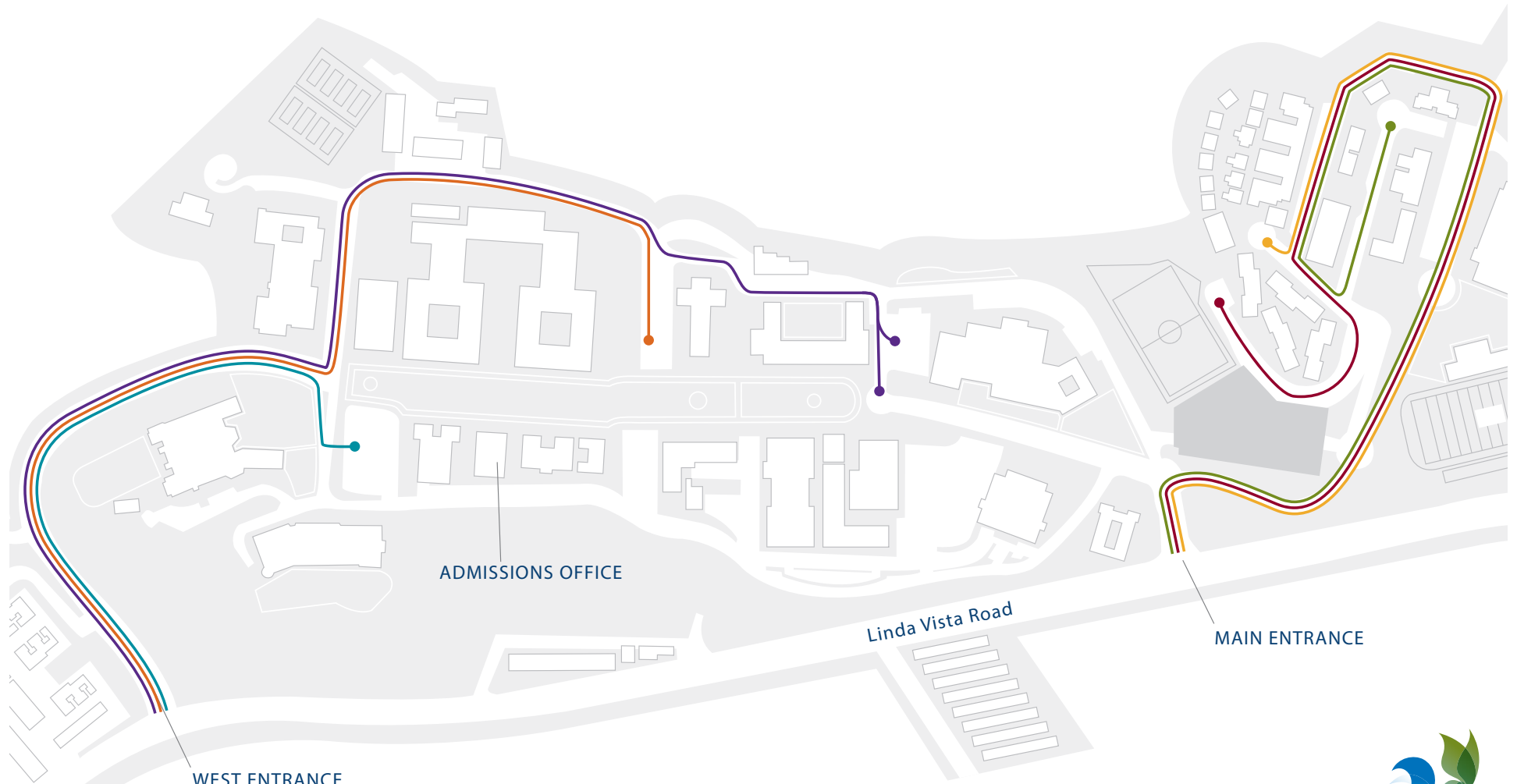
