



## Agreement Acceptance Form

The completion and submission of the *Agreement Acceptance Form* by the student and/or guarantor to the Department of Residential Life constitutes acceptance of the *2009-2010 Terms and Conditions Campus Housing and Dining Services Agreement* ("Agreement"). Upon receipt of this signed *Agreement Acceptance Form*, reasonable effort will be made to assign you to the residence hall of your choice. However, this Agreement does not guarantee the specific hall requested nor room type preferred. Room type (i.e. occupancy) and the applicable room rate are determined by the actual number of Residents in a room on the first class day of each semester (i.e. fall and spring) unless otherwise determined by the Department of Residential Life.

I accept the Agreement, which I have received and read, with the understanding that it will be for the entire academic year which consists of both fall and spring semesters or, if entered into after the beginning of the academic year, for the remainder of the academic year.

I agree to personally assume the financial responsibility described in the Agreement. I understand that the \$250 Room Prepayment is NON-REFUNDABLE for all continuing students. Furthermore, I agree that residents who cancel after July 31 shall be subject to the following late termination fees:

A Resident who receives approval for release from the spring semester portion of the academic year Agreement under clause 10(b)(5) shall be assessed a termination fee of \$1,500 for written requests received by December 31 (or \$2,000 for written requests received after December 31) as financial damages to partially compensate the University for the Resident's early release. Requests for termination based upon issues such as grades, roommate conflicts, noise or dislike of the food will not be considered as compelling reasons for release. These issues can be addressed without canceling the Agreement either by additional effort being made by the Resident, via staff mediation, or a room change request.

The full \$250 Room Prepayment shall also be immediately non-refundable for any new spring semester Resident who subsequently submits an Agreement termination regardless of when the prepayment was made or the reason for termination.

Residence hall move-in dates for returning Residents are noon Monday, August 31, 2009, for fall semester and noon Friday, January 22, 2010 for spring semester. Any Resident granted permission to move into the residence halls prior to the stated occupancy period will be subject to a \$50 per night (room only) charge billed directly to the Resident's University account.

I agree that this Agreement cannot be assigned to another party. I also agree to abide by all student rules and regulations (*Community Standards*) of the University of San Diego residence halls, which are posted on the Residential Life website. I further agree to pay the University of San Diego for the cost of collecting a delinquent account, whether or not any suit or action is commenced.

I understand that I am expected to vacate University housing and cease using my University meal plan as of my last date of class attendance at the University, regardless of whether I have fulfilled the necessary actions to officially withdraw from the University. Therefore, if I choose to continue occupying campus housing (either in person or with my belongings) and/or continue to use my meal plan after my last date of class attendance, I acknowledge that I am personally liable for these ongoing room and meal plan charges. Title IV funds cannot be used to pay any room and meal plan expenses which accrue after my last date of class attendance.
