



Remarkable Leaders in Education Honors 2008 Nomination Criteria

Criteria for Nomination

Nominations may be made for individuals who have made a significant impact/difference in PK-16 education and/or higher education in the San Diego region (including San Diego and Imperial Counties). Nominees may be alive or deceased.

1. Nominees must meet the following criteria to be considered for the “*Remarkable Leaders in Education Recognition Honors.*”

- Acknowledged as having a distinctive vision for education that has resulted in one or more initiatives having significant positive impact in the region.
- Developed one or more education initiatives that significantly changed educational practice in the region.
- Developed education initiatives that resulted in a positive impact on student learning in the PK-16 system, higher education system, or both.



The School of Leadership and Education Sciences' new building, Mother Rosalie Hill Hall, has been completed and is in use by SOLES students, faculty, and staff.

2. Nominations can be made in any of the following three areas:

- Leaders in PK-12 education (ex. A remarkable teacher or principal, etc.)
- Leaders in higher education (ex. A remarkable professor, administrator, school founder, etc.)
- Leaders from the community (e.g. A remarkable community activist, political or civic leaders who made education the focus of their legislative or public careers, etc.)

3. Five periods will be considered by those who make the honors selections:

- Prior to 1800 • 1801-1850 • 1851-1900 • 1901-1950 • 1951-2000
