Description: After the Mexican Revolution, the government encouraged artists like Diego Rivera, David Alfaro Siqueiros, José Clemente Orozco, and Rufino Tamayo to create artistic murals addressed key social and political issues of the day. Gregorio Luke, Director of the Museum of Latin American Art (MoLAA), will talk specifically about the murals of Diego Rivera, which emphasized Mexico’s national identity and culture. Mr. Luke has directed MoLAA since 1999, drawing on a wealth of knowledge and experience to administer the programming of one of the foremost U.S. museums of Latin American art and culture. Mr. Luke regularly lectures on Latin American cultural and personalities. For his tireless contribution to the cultural enrichment of the community in Long Beach, he was recently awarded the Nuestra Imagen Awards from the Community Hispanic Association.
