



## **Percent of Persons Earning More than Five Times the Minimum Wage in Mexico By Municipality, 2000**

Shows the percent of those earning more than five times the minimum wage relative to the total, working population within each municipio\* in Mexico.

Wage data obtained from Instituto Nacional de Estadística Geografía e Informática (INEGI) XII General Population and Housing Survey 2000, *Empleo: Según Ingresos* (<http://sc.inegi.gob.mx/simbad/index.jsp?c=125>) and matched to the respective municipios within INEGI Marco Geoestadístico Municipal (2005) municipio boundary file for Mexico. Those earning more than five times the minimum wage sums those earning: a) more than five times up to (and including) ten times the minimum wage and b) more than ten times the minimum wage. Percent wages calculated by dividing the above sum by the total workforce (the sum of all workers reporting and not reporting wages, as defined by INEGI – see “ingresos por trabajo del hogar según rangos del salarios mínimos).
