The Residential Life Department is in the process of Resident Faculty for the 2007-08 academic year. As you may know, Resident Faculty are USD faculty members who serve 10 hours per week fostering an intellectual climate, and assisting students as mentors and advisors in the residence halls. In addition, Resident Faculty work closely and cooperatively with the residential life staff and student groups to develop a sense of community, implement educational programming and serve as a resource to meet the academic and community needs of resident students. Positions are available in the New Missions Housing, Manchester Village and The Alcala Vista Apartments.

Approximately 460 freshman, sophomore, junior and senior students will live in the New Mission Housing area, which is also known as the "Valley." Manchester Village will house approximately 300, junior, senior and graduate students who choose to participate in the Wisdom for the Real World residential learning program. The Alcala Vista Apartments house approximately 650 students. The majority of these students are sophomores. In each area, Resident Faculty have the opportunity to collaborate with Resident Assistants, Resident Fellows, University Ministry and other Resident Faculty.

Resident Faculty appointments begin with move-in and training in August. Compensation includes an apartment (one or two bedroom based on availability and need) and a meal allowance. Candidates with spouses and/or children are welcome to apply for this position.

To apply for the Resident Faculty position, please submit the following:

- Resume/Curriculum Vita
- Statement of Purpose to include:
  1. Why you are interested in serving as a Resident Faculty.
  2. What will you contribute to the residents' growth and development?
  3. What you hope to gain from this experience.
  4. Ideas about how to create an intellectual climate in the residence halls.
  5. Your understanding of current issues that affect student life in the residence halls.
- Please indicate if you are interested in a particular housing area and why. Please note: this does not guarantee placement in this housing area.
