Eligibility

- All current USD freshmen - juniors are welcome to apply.
- Applicant must not have attended NCORE with USD in the past.
- All participants must be available for the entire week of May 26, 2008 through June 1, 2008.
- The selected participants will depart San Diego on a group flight on Monday, May 26, 2008 and return to San Diego on Sunday, June 1, 2008.

Expectations

- Attendees must attend two pre-conference meetings; fully participate in conference activities including a pre-conference institute, three workshops per day, all keynotes, networking opportunities and scheduled group activities; and two post-conference meetings in early fall semester '08.
- Participants are required to keep a daily reflection journal during the conference, write a two-page reflection paper on their NCORE experience, due within two weeks upon return, highlighting what they might do on campus in fall '08 with the knowledge gained.
- Participants will collaborate with UFMC staff to provide an educational program relating to diversity and inclusion at USD.
