- a. Presentation of New and Returning Student Orgs by Ceci Barron (5 min)
 - i. 4 New Clubs: USD Yoga Club, USD Pilates Club, Club Sailing, and Ceramics Club

- b. Presentation from AVP Dr. Burden and Director of Health Promotion Stephanie Lynch Guariano on Covid, Timely Care, and the National College Health Association survey (30 min)
 - i. Timely Care: 24/7 access for medical care and mental health concerns. There is no cost. Very simple to use and set up services and appointments.
 - ii. Already have had 80+ students use this support/services
 - iii. TimelyCare does not replace any of our existing Student Wellness services, including our after-hours support available through the Counseling Center. TimelyCare is adding to our toolbox of resources!
 - iv. USD students get up to 12 scheduled counseling visits per year with TimelyCare
 - v. All services are available from anywhere in the US and TalkNow is available internationally
 - vi. The Student Health Center remains the primary care provider for students with the USD Health Insurance Plan
 - vii. Questions:
 1. Ari Sambrano – What is the timing for the 12 sessions to reset and continue to have those 12 sessions? The reset dates are August 1st and it will be available through breaks (spring, summer, etc).

2. Sarah Barbar – The counseling appointments, what platforms are used? The standard is video chat and/or can request for just voice.
 3. Eliza Giroux – In terms of the counseling, are you able to stay with one counselor or does it switch? You will be able to see the same counselor throughout your meetings.
 - a. Will student wellness know what communication we have had through this app? Only a one way flow from timely care to USD, but not back to timely care.
 4. Ashika Arasu – Why is it 12 limited sessions, why this specific number and not more or unlimited? This could be because of TimelyCare limit or USD limit, unsure of this.
 5. Logan Tucker – Is there any way that the TimelyCare yoga, stretching, and nutrition options can be recorded if students can make the times given? There are on demand sessions as well that will be provided, but make sure to keep a lookout on the app.

USD Health Survey – covers the following topics: General Health Campus Climate Nutrition Physical Activity Food Security Sleep, COVID 19 Impact Mental Health & Wellbeing Health Care Utilization, Impediments to Academic Performance, Violence, Abusive Relationships, & Personal Safety Tobacco, Alcohol, and Other Drug Use Sexual Behavior & more!
