



# Executive Order No. 1

## Collaborative Engagement within Associated Student Government Branch Events

---

By the authority vested in us as the President and the Executive Board of the Associated Student Government, and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the Associated Student Government of the University of San Diego found in Article V, Section 1, Subsection B, it is hereby ordered as follows:

### Section 1: Purpose

The Associated Student Government (ASG) serves as the representative body for the student population, facilitating communication and advocating for student interests. The purpose of this Executive Order is to foster unity, collaboration, and a comprehensive understanding of the functions of the Associated Student Government (ASG) by mandating participation of all members in events organized by branches other than one's own.

### Section 2: Requirement

Effective immediately, All members of ASG, spanning across the Executive, Legislative, Judicial, and Programming branches, are hereby required to attend and actively contribute to at least one event organized by another branch each semester. This obligation is in addition to their regular responsibilities within their respective branches.

### Section 3: Accountability

- (a) All members are required to report their event attendance to the Chief of Staff within two weeks following the conclusion of the event.
- (b) Any further accountability shall be at the discretion of the Chief of Staff and the Executive Board.
- (c) The Chief of Staff shall maintain records of event attendance and report any discrepancies to the Executive Board and the respective Branch Heads for further action.





#### Section 4: Responsibilities

- (a) Members attending events hosted by other branches shall actively engage in the activities and offer assistance as needed, under the guidance of the event lead.
- (b) Members unable to attend an event due to extenuating circumstances must notify the event lead in advance as much as possible.

#### Section 5: Implementation and Compliance

The Chief of Staff, in conjunction with the rest of the Executive Board, including the President, TPB Chair, Speaker of the Senate, and the Chief Justice shall oversee the implementation of this Executive Order. All changes necessary shall take effect immediately after the issuance of this executive order. They shall ensure that all relevant parties are notified of the decisions. All members and affiliates of the Associated Student Government are required to comply with this Executive Order. Failure to comply with this Executive Order may result in disciplinary action in accordance with ASG Constitution, Bylaws, and regulations executed by the Judicial Branch of ASG.

#### Section 6: Review and Amendments

This Executive Order shall be subject to periodic review, and can be amended or revoked as necessary by subsequent executive orders issued by the ASG Executive Board.

#### Section 7: Effective Date

As voted by a majority of the Executive Board in a unanimous vote, this Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon issuance.
