    - Presenting for 2 GBM requests - submitted it incorrectly
    - **Motion to approve the recategorization to GBM**
  - b. South East Asian Alliance
    - Diwali Celebration on October 24th to celebrate the Hindu, Sikh, and Jain holiday of Diwali
      - Expecting at least 100 attendees
      - Partnering with ISO (ISO is not providing funds)
      - Open to entire USD community
    - Members don't pay dues
    - Food budget is \$500, henna artist budget is \$300, decorations budget is \$100, advertising budget is \$20 - total requested funds is \$920

- **Motion to approve the funding of \$750 out of the \$920 originally requested to allocate towards food and other expenditures such as decorations**
  - **In favor: 7**

c. Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers

- Requesting funds to send 12 members to Phoenix, AZ for SHPE 5-day long national conference (includes speakers and a career fair)
  - Specifically for housing, travel, and registration
  - Approximately \$300-350 per member to go to conference
  - Registration costs solely include attendance fee
- Original \$2,000 portion for registration requested would now go towards \$300 leftover registration cost and the remaining \$1,700 would go towards hotel & lodging
- **Motion to approve the funding of \$900 out of the \$3,000 originally requested to allocate towards the remaining registration fees and lodging**

d. Filipino Ugnayan Student Organization

- Requesting funds for Kamayan Night October 26th 4-8 PM UC Forums A-C
  - Open to entire USD community
  - Purpose of the event is to expose and immerse students and staff to the Filipino tradition
- Food budget is \$1,209.10, outside vendor budget (Halo halo & photobooth) is \$900, decorations budget is \$250.55, miscellaneous budget is \$444.72, prop/costume budget is \$151.65 - total funds requested is \$2,956.02



- a. Filipino Ugnayan Student Organization - Friendship Games
    - Requesting funds for Friendship Games event on October 19th 7 am - 7 pm at California State University Fullerton
      - Purpose of the event is to create a community with other Filipino students in the area
    - Appealing prior ASGBC funding due to unforeseen significant circumstances such as timing of funding and more attendees
      - Additional funding will go towards the second night housing of \$1,990.17
      - Additional members 51-100 would not have to pay any registration fee of sorts
    - **Motion to deny the appeal request for an additional \$1,990.17 that would go towards the second night of lodging**
      - **In favor: 6, abstaining: 1**
