Notes:

1. USD requires 124 total units to graduate, 48 units of which must be upper division (300 or 400 level courses)
2. Some of the core courses at USD will also need to meet the diversity, inclusion and social justice (DISJ) requirements
3. The course plan is subject to core curriculum committee and faculty approval. This should be used as a general guide that may vary based on individual student needs.
4. Business Elective with CADW recommended in year 4
5. Students may need to take classes during intersession of their first year or summer after their first year to fulfill MATH 150 and/or core requirements
6. Student can choose to complete their required internship in either summer after 2nd year or summer after 3rd year
