- 5) If you wish to use Hayes funding to support a research project, please include a two-page research proposal. You are encouraged to work in collaboration with your research mentor to draft the proposal. This research proposal should include a budget, not to exceed \$5,000, which may be applied to travel (conferences or field studies), summer salary, research supplies and summer housing (on campus).
- 6) Return to Dr. Tammy Dwyer via email (tdwyer@san Diego.edu) by November 26, 2018. All materials, including letters of support (emailed to tdwyer@san Diego.edu) must be received by this date. Late applications and materials will not be accepted.

Scholarship requirements:

- 1) You must be majoring in Biology, Biochemistry, Biophysics, Chemistry, Environmental and Ocean Sciences, or Physics. If you are awarded a scholarship, you must remain a student in one of these majors during the award period.
- 2) You must have a grade point average at or higher than a 3.25/4.00. If you are awarded a scholarship, you must maintain a 3.25 GPA or higher to continue the award for the second year.
