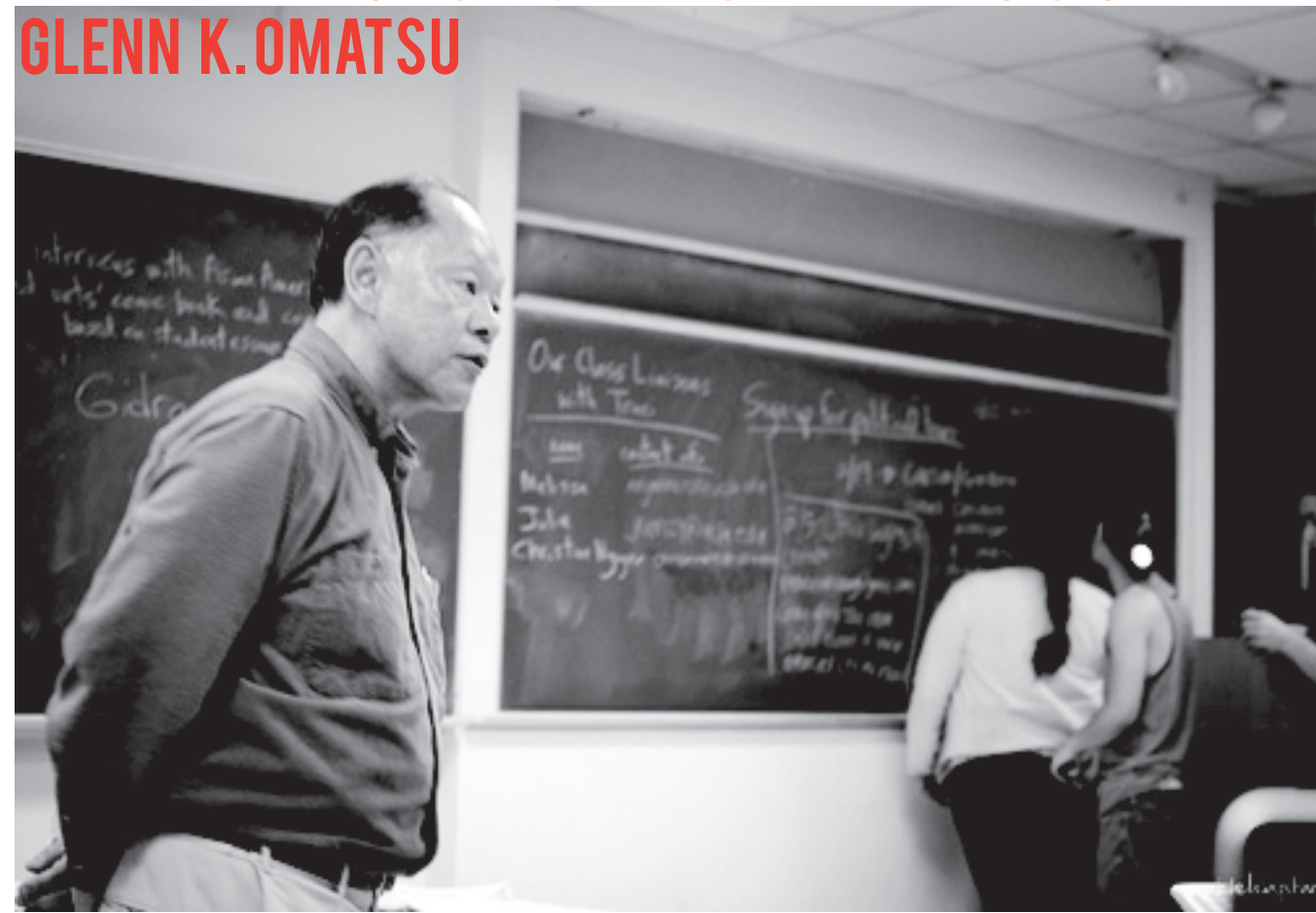


# THE ESSENTIAL ROLE OF COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT IN ETHNIC STUDIES PEDAGOGY

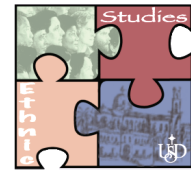
