USD's Chapter of Psi Chi National Honor Society in Psychology invites qualified students to apply for membership. To be eligible for membership in the USD Chapter of Psi Chi, you must have:

1. Declaration of major or minor

- Formally declared major or minor in Psychology **or** Behavioral Neuroscience

2. Coursework

- Completed at least **three semesters** of college coursework
- Completed at least **four courses** (12 units) of graded coursework in Psychology
 - At least one course must be **upper division** with PSYC/NEUR label
 - Transfer students have completed at least two PSYC/NEUR courses at USD

3. GPA

- A cumulative college GPA of **at least 3.3**
- A major GPA of **at least 3.5**
 - This is calculated by adding PSYC 101, PSYC 230, and PSYC 260 grades to your major GPA as reported on DegreeWorks. *Note:* for BN majors, all upper-division major courses count towards this GPA regardless of whether the courses are NEUR/PSYC classes or courses offered in other departments.
 - Transfer students may submit a transcript to the Psi Chi advisors from any schools attended prior to USD so that lower-division grades will count towards the major GPA

The online application will be reviewed each year on January 15th and July 15th; you will be contacted about your membership status within 1 month of those dates.

Once your application is reviewed and it has been determined that you satisfied the requirements for membership, you will be invited to join the Psi Chi Honor Society. *Note that there is a lifetime membership fee of \$55, which you will pay online after your acceptance.*
