



Guidelines to Document a Disability

In order to ensure the provision of reasonable and appropriate accommodation and services to students with disabilities, students must provide current documentation of their disability on their provider's letterhead. Documentation must include:

- a clear diagnostic statement of their disability with DSM V codes
- a description of the manner in which the disability limits the student, the severity and timeframe of the limitation
- test results (if applicable)
- recommendations for accommodations, adaptive devices, and/or assistive services
