ISOLATION CLEANING PROTOCOL In the event of a confirmed COVID-19 positive case

In the event of a confirmed positive case of COVID-19, Facilities Management has established the following isolation cleaning protocol in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines:



The individual space (office, classroom, residence room, etc.) will be immediately secured and closed for 24-hours.



One person from Facilities Management wearing appropriate PPE will apply a misting disinfectant with an electrostatic sprayer throughout the entire space. The space will then be secured for an additional 24-hours.

<u>Please note</u>: any labs or other spaces containing sensitive technical or scientific equipment will <u>not</u> be cleaned without first consulting with the department chair and/or the appropriate faculty member(s).



Facilities Management staff wearing appropriate PPE will subsequently deep-clean the entire space, including sanitizing and disinfecting every surface by hand, after which the space will then be secured for an additional 24-hours.



If vacuuming the space is necessary, Facilities Management will use a vacuum equipped with a high-efficiency particulate air (HEPA) filter.



Finally, one person from Facilities Management staff wearing appropriate PPE will apply a final application of misting disinfectant with an electrostatic sprayer.



After an additional 24-hour waiting period, the space can return to its normal use.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines state that if more than 7 days have passed since the person who is sick has visited or used the facility, additional cleaning and disinfection is not necessary.



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
