I have received video-based training on the safe driving and operation of gas/electric golf carts and on the above date I have received a demonstration of how to operate the cart(s) I will be driving, which included all items on the attached Cart Demonstration Checklist. The following driving rules were discussed and I acknowledge my understanding of them and agree to abide by these rules.

- Cart operators must possess a valid driver's license. 0
- Unless licensed for street usage, carts may only be driven on campus. 0
- Carts are only allowed on sidewalks/plazas for loading/unloading purposes or when Ο other routes and locations are otherwise inaccessible.
- Carts shall not be driven at speeds greater than 15 mph (campus speed limit). Ο
- Slower speeds shall be used around turns and on hills. 0
- All traffic laws shall be obeyed. 0
- Sudden stops and turns shall be avoided when possible 0
- Cell phones, headphones, and radios shall not be used while driving. 0
- Carts shall not attempt to pass other motor vehicles, including other carts. Ο
- Pedestrians always have the right of way. Ο
- Only two people are allowed per bench seat. Passengers are not allowed to ride in Ο cargo beds. Maximum safe occupancy of the cart cannot be exceeded.
- Operators and passengers must remain seated and hold on while the cart is in Ο motion. Driver shall alert passenger when starting to drive.
- The cargo bed shall not be overloaded past capacity that affects operation of the 0 cart. All items must be secured or stored so that they will not fall out of the cart when it is in motion, including food, drinks, and phones.
- Arms, legs and head must be kept in the cart at all times except for lefthand and 0 arm when being used to indicate turn or stop signal.
- The area behind the vehicle must be checked before backing up. Ο
- When parked, the cart shall not block entrances/exits, stairways, disability \cap ramps, or normal vehicular or pedestrian traffic flow.
- The parking brake must be set and keys removed whenever the cart is unattended. Ο
