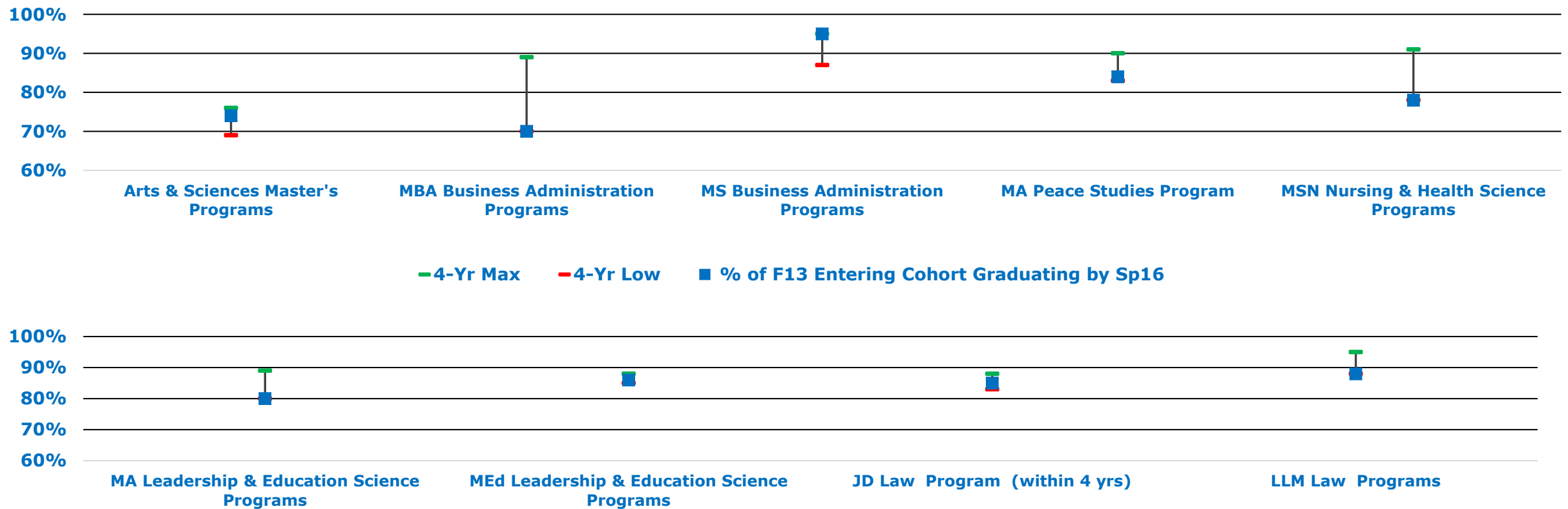

### Graduate Student Success - Three-Year Graduation Rate



Data are from USD's IRP website and include entering fall cohorts from 2010, 2011, 2012, and 2013. A completion period of 150% times the defined program length is consistent with the IPEDS completion period for undergraduate students. Applying this same standard to two-year graduate programs yields a three-year completion period. Please note that the JD Law Program is a three-year program for which a four to five-year period should be allocated for program completion, therefore we provide a four-year graduation rate in the graph for the program. For the Fall 2013 entering cohort the three-year graduation rate for graduate students ranges from 70% to 95%.
