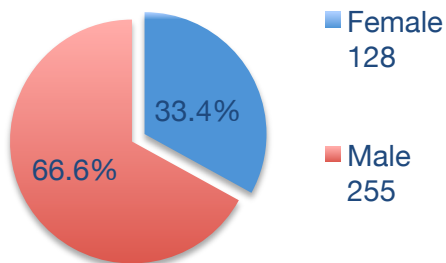

Gender Distribution: Undergraduate Population

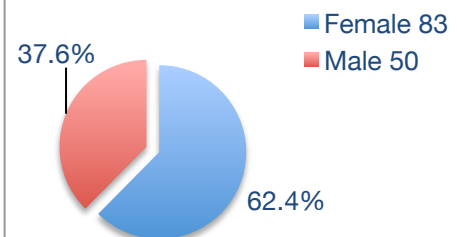
