FINANCIAL AID REMINDERS for USD Students Studying Abroad

Deadlines:

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be filed by March 2nd
- For Intersession and Summer Sessions, follow the deadlines published in the Supplemental Application for the specific term(s). All forms are available on the USD Office of Financial Aid website, <http://www.sandiego.edu/financialaid>

Forms to be completed:

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the Academic Year
- Additional Supplemental Applications for Intersession and/or Summer Sessions if the student will be attending those sessions
- All requirements/follow-up forms as listed in the MySanDiego Portal, on the My Financial Aid page, in the Financial Aid Requirements portlet

Important steps the student needs to take during the financial aid application process, before going abroad:

- File the appropriate Application(s)
- Complete all requirements listed on the portal (Red Flags)
- Check the portal weekly
- If new Red Flags appear, respond immediately
- Make sure the responsible parent(s) is/are listed on the FERPA Form, <https://mysdsvcs.sandiego.edu/eforms/ferpa>
