Study Abroad Scholarship Application Checklist



USD Study Abroad Application - Ensure your online application is
completed and all appropriate fees are turned in by your program's due
date. Click <u>here</u> for the log-in page.
<u>Deadlines</u> - Mark your calendar for each scholarship's deadline. This is
very important, as late applications are typically ineligible.
Scholarship Application - Fill out the appropriate application online or
print and complete by hand.
Essays and/or Personal Statements- Have the Writing Center, peers,
faculty members, etc. revise your essays. Plan on approximately two
weeks for the review process.
<u>Letters of Recommendation</u> - Ask faculty members, employers, etc. for
their endorsement. As with the essays, allow your references at least
two weeks to draft and complete their letters.
Miscellaneous Forms/Documents - Does your scholarship require a
description of your study abroad program? A language proficiency
form? A copy of your FAFSA? Ensure all of these miscellaneous
documents are completed.
<u>Submission</u> - Make sure all of your required documents (this may or may
not be all of the above mentioned details) are completed by the
deadline. Upload them to your online application and submit by the
appropriate date. If mailing your application, make sure to ship them by
the required postmark date. If you are utilizing this option, it is also
suggested that you purchase tracking and/or delivery confirmation.
