The USD International Center is offering a \$500 merit-based scholarship to honor the memory of Professor Gisela Sulzmann, Professor Emeritus of German. The award will be applied to expenses other than tuition and be posted directly to the student's account. Applicants must meet the following qualifications to be eligible for consideration to be awarded this scholarship:

**Eligibility Requirements:**

1. Applicants must be applying to a summer language course abroad offered by the International Center.
2. Applicants must be USD students with a minimum GPA of 3.4.
3. Applicants must complete the application process and be in "Step 3: Enrolled" by the time the award is delivered.
4. Applicants should have no disciplinary violations resulting in probation.
5. Applicants *not* receiving other forms of aid (ROTC, tuition remission, etc.) will be given preference.

Students who fulfill all of the above qualifications may complete the lower portion of this application and return it to the International Center (Serra 201) by their program's original application deadline. Scholarship recipients will be notified via email approximately two weeks after this deadline.
