Purpose

The University of San Diego is pleased to offer Matlab access to the campus community. All faculty, researchers, and students are eligible to download and install these products on their personally-owned computers or on university-issued machines.

Please note that commercial use of MathWorks products is not covered by our Campus-Wide License. If you are using a commercial license, please continue to do so.

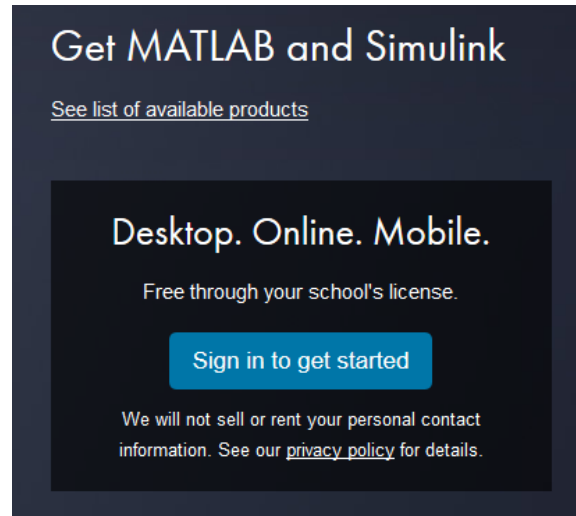
To get started, follow the steps below:

Step 1. Go to the University of San Diego MATLAB Portal

Step 2. Click “Sign in to get started” under the Get MATLAB section.



Step 3. Sign in to your MathWorks Account.

If you do not have an account created, then you will need to create one first.

This MathWorks account **REQUIRES THE USE OF YOUR USD EMAIL ADDRESS**, BUT IS SEPARATE FROM YOUR USD ONE ACCOUNT AND MAY HAVE A DIFFERENT PASSWORD.

While connected to the Internet, run the installer to download your product files and activate.
